

1 3. From approximately 11/15 – 10/16, Respondent acknowledges engaging in a
2 sexual relationship with Client.

3 4. In 06/17, Respondent was involuntarily terminated from her place of employment
4 for her inappropriate relationship with Client.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-3251 *et seq.*
7 and the rules promulgated by the Board relating to Respondent's professional practice as a
8 licensed behavioral health professional.

9 2. The conduct and circumstances described in the Findings of Fact constitute a
10 violation of A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(v), any sexual conduct between a licensee and a client or
11 former client.

12 **ORDER**

13 Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the parties agree to
14 the provision and penalties imposed as follows:

15 1. Respondent's license, LASAC-15160, shall be surrendered to the Board,
16 effective from the date of entry as signed below.

17 2. The surrender shall be considered a revocation of Respondent's license.
