**1. Call to order**

The meeting of the Arizona Board of Behavioral Health Examiners was called to order on September 28, 2010, at 9:07 a.m. with Ms. de Blank presiding.

*A. 2009-0090, Sandra Black, LISAC-10893*

The formal hearing was vacated based on the Board's acceptance of a signed consent agreement.

*B. 2009-0091, Delores Young, LISAC-11359*

The formal hearing was vacated based on the Board's acceptance of a signed consent agreement.

*C. 2010-0127, David Tennyson, LSAT applicant*

Dr. Bowden indicated that the applicant was a student at the college where Dr. Bowden is employed, but there is nothing in that relationship to prevent Dr. Bowden from making an unbiased decision in this matter.

The applicant was properly noticed, but did not appear.

The Board reviewed the applicant's written request for a continuance of the formal hearing scheduled for October 7, 2010.

Mr. Harris opposed the request for a continuance of the formal hearing.

Following review and discussion by members, Ms. Krishna moved, seconded by Dr. Bowden, to deny the request for a continuance of the formal hearing. The motion passed unanimously.

**4. Complaints and other disciplinary matters: review, consideration and action.**

The Board may go into executive session to discuss records exempt from public inspection pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(2) or to obtain legal advice pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3).

*Pending complaints represent unproven allegations. On investigation, many complaints are found to be without merit or not of sufficient seriousness to merit disciplinary action against the licensee and are dismissed.*

*A. 2009-0090, Sandra Black, LISAC-10893*

Mr. Harris reviewed the proposed consent agreement for the voluntary surrender of the professional's license.

The professional was not present. The professional's attorney, Larry Cohen, was present and addressed the Board.

Following review and discussion by members, Dr. Bowden moved, seconded by Mr. Mitchell, to accept the proposed signed consent agreement for the voluntary surrender of the professional's license. The motion passed unanimously. See attached roll call vote.

*B. 2009-0091, Delores Young, LISAC-11359*

Mr. Harris reviewed the proposed consent agreement for the voluntary surrender of the professional's license.

The professional was not present. The professional's attorney, Larry Cohen, was present and addressed the Board.

Following review and discussion by members, Mr. Mitchell moved, seconded by Dr. Bowden, to accept the proposed signed consent agreement for the voluntary surrender of the professional's license. The motion passed unanimously. See attached roll call vote.

*C. 2008-0082, Eve Mayer, LCSW-0211*

Mr. Harris reviewed practice concerns identified by the professional's clinical supervisor under a pending Board consent agreement.

The professional was properly noticed, but did not appear.

Following review and discussion by members, Dr. Gabler moved, seconded by Dr. Bowden, to accept the proposed consent agreement, which prohibits the professional from practicing under her license until it expires and prohibits her from renewing her license after it expires. The motion passed unanimously. See attached roll call vote.
