CONSENT AGREEMENT

RESPONDENT

In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of the above captioned matter, consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and responsibilities of the Arizona State Board of Behavioral Health Examiners (“Board”), and pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 32-3281(F) and 41-1092.07(F)(5), Todd Rosenblatt (“Respondent”) and the Board enter into this Consent Agreement, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Consent Agreement”) as a final disposition of this matter.

RECITALS

Respondent understands and agrees that:

1. Any record prepared in this matter, all investigative materials prepared or received by the Board concerning the allegations, and all related materials and exhibits may be retained in the Board’s file pertaining to this matter.

2. Respondent has the right to a formal administrative hearing at which Respondent can present evidence and cross examine the State’s witnesses. Respondent hereby irrevocably waives their right to such formal hearing concerning these allegations and irrevocably waives their right to any rehearing or judicial review relating to the allegations contained in this Consent Agreement.

1 3. According to information and records available from the Maricopa County
2 Superior Court, on 03/16/18, Respondent was formerly charged with 3 counts of sexual
3 exploitation of a minor; all Class 2 felonies.

4 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-3251 *et seq.*
6 and the rules promulgated by the Board relating to Respondent's professional practice as a
7 licensed behavioral health professional.

8 2. The conduct and circumstances described in the Findings of Fact constitute a
9 violation of A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(l), any conduct, practice or condition that impairs the ability of
10 the licensee to safely and competently practice the licensee's profession.

11 **ORDER**


12 Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, the parties agree to

14 1. Respondent's license, LASAC-15101, shall be surrendered to the Board,
15 effective from the date of entry as signed below.

16 2. The surrender shall be considered a revocation of Respondent's license.
