

1 4. Respondent acknowledges engaging in a sexual relationship with Client.

2 5. As a result of her conduct, Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender her
3 professional counseling license.

4 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5 1. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-3251 *et seq.*
6 and the rules promulgated by the Board relating to Respondent's professional practice as a
7 licensed behavioral health professional.

8 2. The conduct and circumstances described in the Findings of Fact constitute a
9 violation of A.R.S. § 32-3251(16)(v), any sexual conduct between a licensee and a client or
10 former client.

11 **ORDER**

12 Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, the parties agree to
13 the provision and penalties imposed as follows:

14 1. Respondent's license, LPC-11901, shall be surrendered to the Board, effective
15 from the date of entry as signed below.

16 2. The surrender shall be considered a revocation of Respondent's license.
