3. Report from the Executive Director and/or staff

A. Review consideration, and possible action regarding notice of termination of rulemaking of A.A.C. R4-6-217(B)(2)(a)(i)

Ms. Zavala updated the members regarding the rule package that is currently in front of the Governor's Regulatory Review Council (GRRC). She shared that the Governor's office has advised the Board to terminate the rule package at this time, and that they are committed to working with staff to develop a more comprehensive rule package that will add additional public protections.

Zaida Dedolph Piecoro, Governor's Health Policy Adviser, shared with the Board that they were supportive of the proposed rules, and they will work with the Board on a new rule package and submission to GRRC so the proposed package has a greater chance of approval by GRRC.

Ms. Zavala indicated the August Board agenda would include agenda language to ratify the language to include the entire rule package.

After review and discussion, Ms. Kramer moved, seconded by Mr. Davis, to remove R4-6-217 (B)(2)(a)(i). The motion passed unanimously.
